Chapter 8: Advent of the Aryans and the Age of Rig Vedas

1. Original Home and Identity: PAGE 70:

All Aryans – not same race – but they had same culture and common language (Indo-european language - IEL). Originally they lived in the steppes (southern-RUS to Central Asia) \rightarrow moved to central asia \rightarrow Iran \rightarrow India.

- Earliest life they led pastoral but later Agriculture.
- Male dominated society
- Animals esp. Horse played important role.
- In Rig Veda Term Aryan appears 36 times; earliest text in IEL; It is a collection of prayers offered to gods. Consists of 10 mandalas/books of which Book 2-6 (latest); Rig veda has much similarity of usage of words with Iranian language Avesta (same names for gods + social classes)
- Other inscription found elsewhere indicating Aryans?

PAGE 71:

- Aryans used socketed –axes, bronze dirks, and swords; horse sacrifices (Tajikistan & swat valley (pak)).
- Lived in East Afghan, N-W Frontier province, Punjab and fringes of Western UP.
- They mention:

Kubha (afghan river);

Indus (or sindhu- excellent river as per them) and its five branches;

Naditarna (Sarawasti river along with Ghaggar-Hakra channel, based on the name of Avestan river Harakhwati/Helmand river in Afghan)

- Area they 1st settled is known as LAND OF THE SEVEN RIVERS; Earliest people came during 1500 BC and came into conflict with indigenous Inhabitants (dasas, dosyus)
- As per rig veda, Sambara was defeated by the Chief Divodasa (of Bharata clan);
 Dasyus original Inhabitants and Aryan Chief who empowered them –Trasadasyu
- Dasyuhatya means Slaughter of dasyus. These people worshipped phallus + kept cattle not for dairy products.

2. Tribal Conflicts: PAGE 71:

- Many defeats inflicted by Indra/ purnadara breaker of forts + horse chariot +
 Coats of mail (varman) + better arms.
- Two types of conflicts:

3. Social Divisions: PAGE 75:

- ✓ They were Conscious of their physical appearance.
- ✓ Varna = colour. Aryans = fair + Indigenous = dark + Complexion.
- ✓ Creation of social division = was due to conquest of indigenous inhabitants i.e., dasas and dasyus - conquered by Aryans - treated as slaves + shudras.
- ✓ Until 10th book of rig veda, there was only 3 divisions, 4th was shudras (added at the end of rig-vedic period)
- ✓ Varna = based on occupation + social inequalities helped rise of princes + priests.
- ✓ As people were pastoral, No gift of land/cereals/ wage-earners (only slaves).
- ✓ Social division NOT based on tax collection/accumulation of land.
- ✓ Society = tribal + Egalitarian.

4. Rig Vedic Gods : PAGE 76 :

- ✓ Personified Natural forces
- ✓ Indra- breaker of forts / rain god/ chief led to victory against demons.
- ✓ Agni/ Fire was important.

- ✓ Varuna / Water upholded natural order/ whatever happened in this world is because of his desires.
- ✓ Soma / God of plants.
- ✓ *Maruts* /Storm
- ✓ Femal divinities : *Aditi + Usha* (appearance of dawn) not prominent.
- ✓ Mode of worship: Recitation of prayers + offering of sacrifices. Every tribe had special god, to which they prayed in chorus.
- ✓ Magical powers = not important.

Chapter 9: The Later vedic Phase: Transition in State and Social Orders

- 1. Expansion in the Later Vedic Period (1K 500 B.C): PAGE 78
 - Collection of vedic hymns/mantras= Samhita.
 - 1) Rig veda samhita (early vedic age)
 - 2) Sama veda samhita (Modified collection)
 - 3) Yajur veda samhita (hymns + rituals during recitation)
 - 4) Atharva veda samhita (Charms + spells to ward off evils and diseases)
 - Samhita followed by series of texts known as Brahmanas.

These were found at PGW sites: People inhabited here used earthen bowls + dishes made of Painted pottery.

- Kurus occupied: Delhi + upper portion of Ganga –Yamuna doab = Kurukshetra/land of Kurus.Kuru tribe is important in Mahabhartha.
- Kurus wiped out after the big battle (kauravas and Pandavas)
- People did not know use of Burnt bricks.
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Chapter 10: Jainism and Buddhism

62 religious sects arose in Middle Gangetic plains - 2nd half of 6th century

- 1. Causes of Origin: PAGE 89:
- Post vedic times, varna was discriminatory to shudras (Higher the varna the more privileged + purer the person was)
- even 3rd division vaishyas (placed in category of dvija/twice –born) can wear sacred thread + read vedas.

Shudras – treated as slaves/untouchables.

CAUSES OF RISE OF NEW RELIGIONS: PAGE 90-91.

- ✓ Kshatriyas (rulers) reacted strongly to domination of Brahmanas. This resulted in origins of new religions. Varadhamana Mahavira (MV) + Gautama Buddha (GB) (belonged to Kshatriya + disputed the dominance of brahmanas)
- ✓ New –Agricultural economy: To clear dense forest; we need iron plough + bullocks. Vedic practice of killing cattle stood in this way i.e., Stopping of killing of cattle is required for stable agricultural economy
- ✓ Vaishyas tried to improve from their 3^{rd} position . (As *coins* played important in their trade) + New religions did not give importance to varna.
- ✓ Keywords: Setthis Merchants
- ✓ Non-violence end to wars
- ✓ Need to do business of moneylending this was not acceptable to brahmanical book –dharmasutras.
- ✓ Social Inequalities inflicted by existing religions.
- 1. Varadhamana Mahavira and Jainism: PAGE 91-92
 - ✓ Origin: Very ancient times 24 Tirthankaras / Great teachers.
 - ✓ 1ST: Rishabhadev / 24th V.Mahavira (Born in 540 BC in Kundagrama (Vaishali); father: Siddhartha (Jnatrika clan of Kshatriya); Mother: Licchhavi.
 - ✓ V.Mahavira became ascetic at AGE 30; Attained *Kaivalya (Juan*) to conquer misery+ happiness- at 42; because of this he is known as Jina/great hero.
- 2. Doctrine of Jainism: PAGE 92:
 - ✓ FIVE : No violence / lie/stealing/acquisition of property and observe continence (Brahmacharya)
 - ✓ Importance to Ahimsa /Non-violence
 - ✓ Shvetambaras (put white dress) V. Digambaras (Naked)
 - ✓ God is lower than Jina
 - ✓ Did not condemn varna (justified the varna; birth is based on sins committed in past)
 - ✓ Freedom from Wordly bonds: How> Triratna: RIGHT (knowledge,faith, right Actio
- 3. Contribution of Jainism: PAGE 94:

- ✓ Mitigated evils of varna system +ritualistic vedic religion.
- ✓ Sanskrit discarded, with prakrit language +ardhamagadhi(Religious literature) compiled at Valabhi, Gujarat + development of regional languages.
- ✓ Important works : Apabhramsha
- ✓ Image –worshippers.

4. Gautama Buddha and Buddhism: PAGE 94:

- ✓ G.B.- Contemporary of MV
- ✓ Born in Shakya Kshatriya clan on 563 BC in Nepal (Kapilavastu)
- ✓ Looked for solution of misery at Age 29 wandered for 7 years and attained knowledge at Bodh Gaya under a pipal tree = Known as Buddha/enlightened.
- ✓ 1st sermon : Sarnath in Banaras
- ✓ Defeated the staunch supports of rival sects with debates.
- ✓ Missionary activities: did not discriminate on basis of rich/poor.

5. <u>Doctrine of Buddhism: PAGE 95:</u>

- Practical reformer GB
- No controversies on soul and other things; miseries of birth & death cycle can be done away with, if one attains nirvana (a stage without desire)
- 8 fold path (Astangika marga)
- Told to avoid excess of luxury + austerity : follow middle path.
- Code of conduct what are they?
